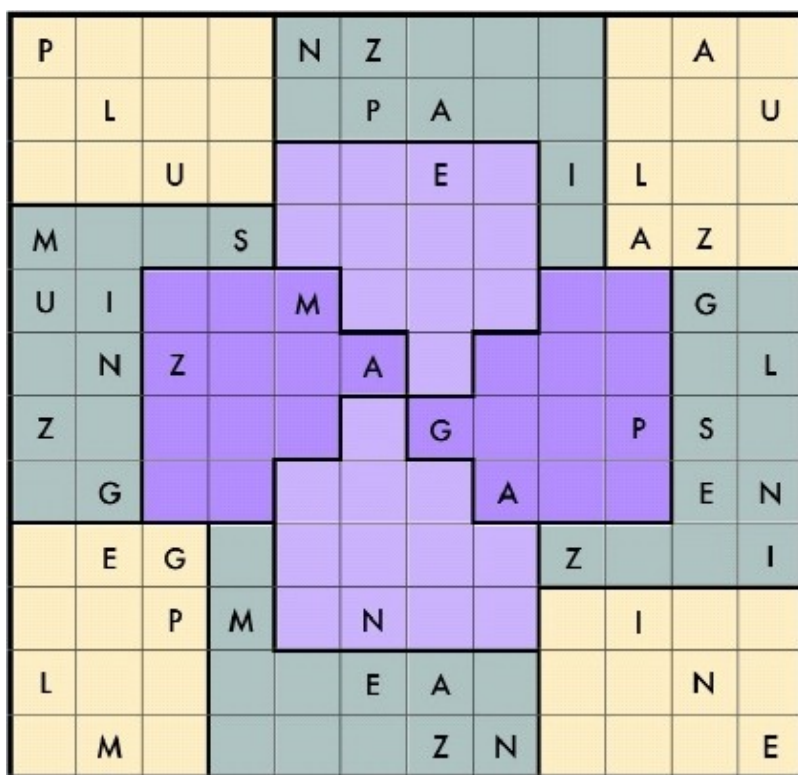


***Plus* magazine sudoku**
